My main job right now is training teachers. I need to be twins to get it all done! We have four new teachers this year.

It has been chilly at night here lately, and I have the beautiful crocheted blanket on my bed. It has come in very handy. I know you will not think of 70° as chilly, but for us, that is a drop of 20-30 degrees!

We recently got some used Macs for the schools. Our big problem now is having the electricity to use them! The school in Sabana Perdida only gets electricity for the last fifteen minutes of the school day! The other school has electricity sporadically throughout the week, so they are able to use the computer in classes more.
